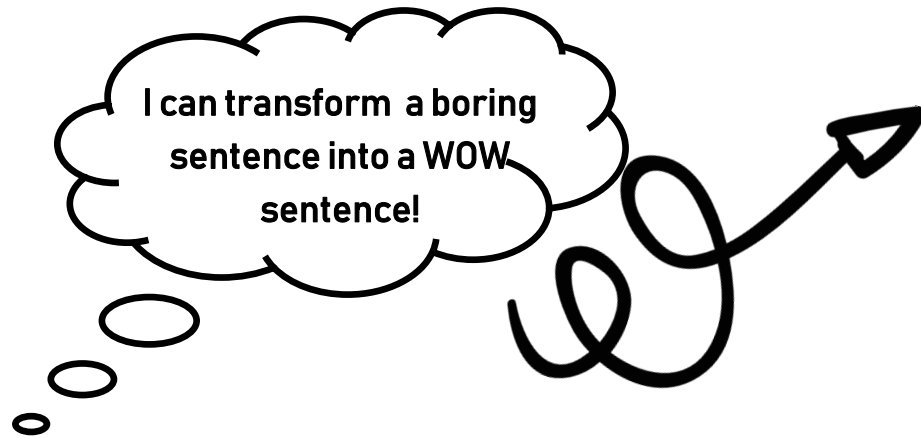
"Let's bump up"
